

GARDEN ROUTE – 7 DAYS/6 NIGHTS

Day 1: Arrive George

On arrival at George Airport you will be met and assisted to the Avis Car Hire depot, where you will collect your hired vehicle. Make your way to George. Here you will spend the next three nights.

Day 2: Fancourt Country Club (B)

Play a round of golf at [Fancourt Country Club](#) (Montagu/Outeniqua) today. Here, a challenging game of golf meets the requirements of the most demanding golfers as well as assisting in improving the golfer's technique and strategy. This afternoon we suggest a visit to Oudtshoorn, known as the 'Feather Capital' of the world because of its large ostrich industry. Enjoy a tour of an ostrich farm. Visit the Cango Caves, regarded as one of South Africa's foremost natural wonders.

Day 3: Knysna / Sparrebosch Country Club (Pezula) (B)

This morning take a leisurely drive and travel along the picturesque Garden Route to Knysna. Make your way to Sparrebosch Country Club and enjoy a round of golf. This course offers breathtaking views over Knysna Lagoon and the Indian Ocean, with the 14th hole built right on the breach of the cliffs. A late afternoon boat cruise on the Knysna Lagoon offers the perfect ending to a wonderful day.

Day 4: George / Plettenberg Bay / Plettenberg Bay Golf Course (B)

Travel along the heart of the Garden Route via Knysna to Plettenberg Bay, where you will spend 2 nights. Enjoy a round of golf at Plettenberg Bay Golf Club, a scenic parkland course situated in a nature reserve.

Day 5: Goose Valley Golf Course (B)

Today, tee off at Goose Valley Golf Course. As it is close to the sea in what Gary Player, the course designer describes as 'one of the most stunning sites for a golf course anywhere in the southern Cape Coast, the golf course follows the style of the Scottish links courses. The sweeping, panoramic views of the lagoon and sea with the Outeniqua Mountains as a backdrop, makes this an unforgettable golf experience.

Day 6: Plettenberg Bay / Port Elizabeth (B)

Continue along the remainder of the Garden Route through the Tsitsikamma Forests to Port Elizabeth, set on the shores of Algoa Bay. Spend the night in Port Elizabeth.

Day 7: Humewood Golf Course / Depart Port Elizabeth (B)

Enjoy a game of golf at the Humewood Golf Club. The course is surrounded by coastal bush and, although it is close to the centre of Port Elizabeth, one sees very little evidence of human encroachment. Humewood is characterised by thick coastal bush, swales, humps and hollows. This afternoon board your flight out of Port Elizabeth; alternatively enjoy a few nights at one of the Eastern Cape Private Game Reserves.
