7 DAY GOLF TOUR ITINERARY

Monday 8 March

DAY 1: Hong Kong / Mission Hills, Shenzhen (D)
Depart from your home airport this morning and arrive in Hong Kong late afternoon /early evening. Your driver will meet you at the airport for your transfer into China and the renowned **Mission Hills Golf Resort**. Guests staying at the Sheraton Hong Kong & Towers will have the morning to shop and do a little sightseeing before meeting your driver in the foyer of your hotel around midday. You will then be transferred to **Mission Hills Golf Resort**.

This evening enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the resort in preparation for the feast of great golf to come.



Tuesday 9 March

DAY 2: Mission Hills, Shenzhen (B)
This morning after a relaxed breakfast start your Mission Hills experience by teeing off at the well known 7,214-yard **Norman Course**. It reflects the perfect combination of golf course style and nature. The front 9 holes meander through mountain ridges and the hillside, while the back 9 holes are set in a valley. The narrow fairways, surrounded by long grass and dense forest vegetation contribute to the course's difficulty index of over 150, which is one of the highest in Asia. Accurate golfing strategy is key to conquering this "Tournament Course".

Wednesday 10 March

DAY 3: Mission Hills, Shenzhen (B)
Opened in early 1999 to great critical acclaim, tee off today at the **Faldo Course**. It is destined to become Asia's premier tournament venue. One of the world's toughest island greens is the 16th, the ultimate in target golf, Nick Faldo has used his outstanding shot-making skills to design an extremely challenging course for major professional championships. Every hole is highly strategic yet eminently playable.

Thursday 11 March

DAY 4: Mission Hills, Shenzhen (B)
Today you play the 7,400-yard **Olazabal Course** and the longest at Mission Hills. As the venue of the 2007 and 2008 Omega Mission Hills World Cup the design philosophy behind this course is to create a beautiful,

unique, harmonious and playable course for all golfers, reflecting Jose Maria Olazabal's reputation as one of the game's best sand savers. Even the best of golfers will find this course a challenge.



Friday 12 March

DAY 5: Mission Hills, Shenzhen (B,D)
Venue of the 41st World Cup of Golf in 1995, this masterpiece designed by legendary golf champion Jack Nicklaus is revered throughout the world as the most magnificent golfing challenge in Asia. Today you play this famous **World Cup Course**, the first in China accredited by the US PGA Tour for major professional competitions. Many top players like Tiger Woods, Greg Norman have found this a great course to play. This evening enjoy a farewell dinner and presentations at the Resort.

Saturday 13 March

DAY 6: Mission Hills, Shenzhen (B)
This morning we tee off at the **Ozaki Course**. This course takes advantage of the dramatic terrain by playing largely through single corridor valleys offering elevated tees and fairways surrounded by native slopes. The intent was to leave as much native vegetation as possible to create a mature look when the course opened. Dramatic long views into valley corridors, often including serene lakes, give the golfer a feeling of being surrounded by nature. The course begins with a long par-4 and ends with the tee shot on 18 lined up at the impressive hotel/clubhouse framed between two mountain peaks. This par-5 ends at a double green (shared with the 9th) set above a lake and in front of a towering exposed rock face.

Sunday 14 March

DAY 7: Depart Mission Hills (B)
Today it is time to say our goodbyes and check out of the resort. You will be transferred to Hong Kong International Airport in plenty of time to join your flight home.

Traveller's choosing to stay on in Hong Kong will be transferred to their hotel. Traveller's joining the 7 day Beijing / Xian Encounter Tour will be transferred to the airport for your onward flight.

DAY 1: Beijing

Upon Arrival in Beijing you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

DAY 2-4: Beijing (B,L, one dinner)

Three full days visiting sights which have captured the imagination of mankind – the magnificent Summer Palace, the exquisite Temple of Heaven, the splendours of the Forbidden City – as well as Tiananmen Square. See the Pandas at Beijing Zoo. Tour the 'hutongs' – the back alleys' – by cycle rickshaw where you can see Chinese life at it's most traditional and obtain a fascinating behind-the-scenes glimpse into the lifestyles of the local people. Visit the Silk Market and make a stop at a cloisonné factory where you can appreciate the intricate manufacture of this craftwork. Spend a day visiting the Sacred Way, the Exhibition Hall of the Ming Tombs and the Great Wall, truly one of the world's greatest wonders. Enjoy a Peking Duck dinner and an exciting performance of 'The Legend of Kung Fu' during your stay.

DAY 5: Beijing / Xian (B, L, D)

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Xian where you will spend two nights. In the evening enjoy a Tang Dynasty cultural show and dinner.

DAY 6: Xian (B,L)

In Xian you will marvel at amazing archaeological wonders – the Terracotta Army of Emperor Qin Shi Huang, the Chariot Exhibition, the Shaanxi History Museum, Big Wild Goose Pagoda and the City Wall.

DAY 7: Transfer to Xian airport. (B)

It is advisable to book a return trip to Beijing from Australia (stopping in Hong Kong in both directions) if you wish to combine the Mission Hills Tour with the Beijing / Xian tour extension. An additional domestic flight between Xian and Beijing would also be required. This is the most cost effective flight itinerary.
